# 27 October Members' Meeting Program "Whales are Back in New York Waters" by Lisa Piastuch

This program was 'in-person' and via Zoom. There were 12 participants at the Olympia Diner, and 18 via Zoom. Members connected locally from CT and Springfield, MA; and Zoomed all the way from New Smyrna Beach, FL. Thanks to Lt Frank Pascucci Jr.,AP, Lt/C James Salvatore, AP, and D/Lt Cliff McKibbon, SN, for their preliminary, and in-person technical assistance to make this presentation a reality.

Lisa Piastuch gave great insight into the New York Bight Whale Monitoring Program, explaining the marine environment, emphasizing the importance of protecting marine resources, means of surveillance; and future goals. This included development of a long-term monitoring program. A number of slides were featured, including: the New York Bight Survey Area, Whale and Sea Turtle species, and Aerial & Acoustic Survey results. Lisa also answered questions from Zoom attendees. This made for an entertaining and informative evening.
